



THE TASTE OF BERICI HILLS

Full day-excursion

Modality: by bike - **Length:** 50 km

Starting from the Point Bike Point in Longare, leave the **Riviera Berica** cycling track and begin to ride along the bank of the Bacchiglione River.

After 3 km, open your gastronomic tour with a stop at the farmhouse Villa Feriani, starting with a tasting of typical products such as jams, vegetables in oil and salami of the highest quality.

When you reach the town of **Montegalda**, with its castle and the villa from the centuries-old park, take the opportunity to visit the historic Distillery Brunello, one of the oldest in Italy.

Get back on your bike and ride along the Bacchiglione until the cycling track.

After 8 km, you will reach the charming village of Costozza. Stop for lunch at the trattoria "Al Volto" where you can enjoy local specialities such as "baccalà alla vicentina" and truffles of berici.

Dedicate the afternoon to the knowledge of local wines, with a tasting in one of the wineries of the itinerary.

The sportiest people, who want to face the gentle slopes of Berici, can choose **Pegoraro Winery in Mossano**, situated 11 km from Costozza, an ancient monastery of 1200

surrounded by vineyards. Here you can taste local wines of elegant simplicity and immediacy such as Tai and Garganega.

In Mossano you can take the opportunity for a walk in the enchanting "**Valle dei Mulini**". Another option for an easier ride is to reach the beautiful countryside home that houses the **Winery Piovene Porto Godi** in the town of Toara, which means Good Land. The winery is located 16 km from **Costozza**, the route is slightly longer but has no slopes. After the wine tasting you can take the way back to be at the **Bike Point of Longare** for the late afternoon.
